

This kit contains items that may be choking hazards for small children. We recommend this kit for Ages 7+.

Knitting is a craft that is great for kids, teens and adults! While it can feel intimidating to start knitting, we hope this kit and these resources will motivate you to jump in and learn a new skill.

GETTING STARTED

- Lay out all of the tools in this kit and learn their names. You will find:
 - Knitting Needles of different sizes
 - 1 Ball of Yarn, called a Skein
 - Measuring Tape
 - Tapestry Needle (large sewing needle)
 - Stitch Markers
- All you need to start is a pair of Knitting Needles and Yarn. The rest of these tools can be used for different types of knitting projects.

'K' AND 'P'


- Reading a knitting pattern, like the one included in this kit, can be daunting. Just remember, the single letters stand for a single knitting technique. The two most common stitches are Knit and Purl. Once you know how to Knit and Purl, you can learn almost any pattern!

- P = Purl stitch: https://youtu.be/bbtnjHrb_Hg


